Got Math?

- **Dropping a math class**, but still want to do something for the remainder of the semester to improve your skills before trying again?
- **Wanting to review math skills** before taking math next semester?

MTH 122 may be right for you!

- It is a **flexible-paced** alternative to the lecture format.
- It uses an online learning and assessment system to **customize a learning path** based on what you already know, not what the teacher has to cover.
- You work independently on the computer for at least 22 hours for $\frac{1}{2}$ unit (44 hours for 1 unit) but check-in with the instructor once a week to ask questions.
- After 44 hours of work, you may **re-take the Chabot Math Assessment** before the end of the six-month waiting period.
- The emphasis is helping you learn and retain, not assigning a grade.
- MTH 122 is available for curriculum up to Precalculus.
- Not recommended for those students who need external pressure to make progress.
